



Children's Camp Packing List 2026

- **Bedding:** For our twin bunk beds, please bring sheets, blankets, or a sleeping bag and pillow.
- **Towels:** Bring towels for both swimming/water activities and showering.
- **Clothes and Extra Clothes:** It's always good to have a few extras—laundry facilities are available on camp for emergencies.
- **Swim Suit:** Appropriate swimsuits, please, no bikinis or Speedos
- **Personal Hygiene Items:** Toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, body wash, face wash, shampoo, and conditioner. Hair brush. Feminine hygiene products, if needed
- **Comfortable footwear:** Running shoes and sandals.
- **Daily Medications:** These will be turned in to the nurse at check-in.
- **Water bottle:** We suggest writing your camper's name on their water bottle.
- **Snack Shack Money:** This can be checked in during registration, or your camper can be responsible for their money. We recommend \$10-\$30.
- **Snacks:** Your camper is welcome to bring their own non-perishable snacks.
- **Bible, journal, and pens**
- **Sunscreen, Bug, and Tick Repellent**
- **Sunglasses and Hats:** Optional, but definitely come in handy.
- **Small Drawstring Bag or Backpack:** Optional, but highly recommended, as it will come in handy for carrying their bible, water bottle, and towel.
- **Flashlight:** Another optional item, but again handy to have.

Please do not bring cell phones, tablets, or computers. Your camper can turn their electronics in to you at check-in. If you would like to contact your camper for any reason, you are always welcome to call the office phone number or text Sadee Bruce at 816-922-0200.
